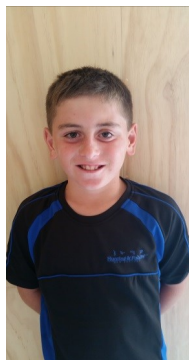
Spare Clothes

Rimu Room: **Navella Weston** for drawing a plan that has creative ideas, and **Kyle Fawkner** for trying very hard with his times tables.

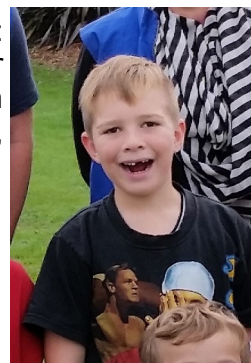


Matai Room: **Jessica Woods** for putting her best effort into all school work, and

Kowhai Room: **Taytan West** for being helpful in the classroom,




and **Shani McClutchie** for using her initiative in class and out in the playground.
